About the Application

- The Application cannot be saved. We suggest you prepare your application offline first.
- You must have had a conversation with someone else about your proposal.
- There is a limit of 2000 characters for each of the sections under 'Your proposal', this equates to approx 300 words.
- Your project, or the activity leading up to the project, must be happening within the next nine months.

Award Selection

We are looking for applications from artists who demonstrate a critical framework in approach and a desire to challenge their practice and create/develop innovative and experimental work.

This is about your development and how this opportunity can support and develop your ambition and ideas. Your intentions must be clearly laid out in the proposal alongside your commitment to developing outstanding art practice.

A panel of judges will assess applications and a decision will be made in late March / early April 2018.

Due to the volume of applications we receive and staff capacity, we regret that we are unable to provide feedback to unsuccessful applicants.
